Psychological Associate Complex Care and Recovery Program Geriatric Mental Health Outpatient Clinics

Position Description:

The Centre for Addiction and Mental Health is currently seeking a full-time contract Psychological Associate for the Complex Care and Recovery Program and its services that focus on the Geriatric Mental Health Outpatient Clinics. The Geriatric Mental Health Outpatient Clinics support individuals (60+ with impairments related to psychoses, memory, and mood) their families and the community agencies dedicated to supporting this population. Clients served by this program are offered specialized services and customized care across an inpatient, outpatient and community based continuum of care.

Reporting to the Manager, the successful candidate will be responsible for duties related to administering and interpreting neuropsychological measures, preparing neuropsychological assessment reports, and/or court ordered reports, as well as providing feedback to clients and families.

The successful candidate will also work in an interprofessional context and collaborate with other disciplines. You will support the research objectives of the program as well as the academic mandate by supervising and providing support to clinical students. You will support a healthy workplace that embraces diversity, encourages teamwork and complies with all applicable regulatory and legislative requirements. This position is currently located at 1001 Queen Street West.

Qualifications:

- The successful candidate will possess a Master's degree in Clinical Psychology
- Registered member in good standing as a Psychological Associate with no restrictions in autonomous practice with the College of Psychologists of Ontario
- The position requires two (2) years of post-masters clinical experience working with the adult and seniors populations.
- The ability to provide focused psychological assessments utilizing standardized assessment measures is required;
- A current or in-progress competency/specialization in Geriatrics is preferred.
- A current or in-progress Neuropsychology specialization is preferred.
- Demonstrated ability to administer, score and interpret neuropsychological tests is required.
- Excellent organizational, interpersonal, and written communication skills and the ability to work effectively in a fast-paced clinical environment are also essential.
- Computer skills, including word processing, electronic communication, relevant psychological assessment tool software and hospital workload measures are essential.
- Proficiency with Microsoft office (Excel, Outlook, Word) is essential
- Excellent interpersonal, written and verbal communication and organization skills are required.
- The ability to provide culturally competent service to clients of diverse ethno-racial and cultural backgrounds is essential and experience working in a multi-system, inter-professional environment is required.
- Bilingualism (French/English) or proficiency in a second language would be an asset.
