Contract Summary:

Reporting to the Program Director Autism Services, the contract Psychologist / Psychological Associate will be responsible for completing 2-6 psychological assessments per month based out of Markham. Assessments include those involving autism, intellectual disabilities and learning disabilities.

Duties & Responsibilities:

Key responsibilities include: Completing psychological assessments and assessment reports of children as young as 2 up to young adulthood in order to provide appropriate recommendations based on the findings. Psychometry support will be provided.

Qualifications:

- A Master's degree and/or a Ph.D. in Psychology is required.
- Be registered and a member in good standing with the College of Psychologists of Ontario.
- Strong clinical assessment skills in child and adolescent mental health. Proficiency and experience in assessment of autism, intellectual disabilities, learning disabilities, ADHD from young childhood up to 25 years of age.
- Evidence of having completed formal training and of having experience using the ADOS-2 for all age groups.
- Strong written communication skills.
- An ability to be flexible and responsive in delivering services.
- Demonstrated clinical experience, proven communication, organizational, and interpersonal skills, and the ability to work effectively as a team member.
- Some travel may be necessary.
- Knowledge concerning cultural diversity and proficiency in other languages will be considered assets for this position.
- Satisfactory Criminal Record Check (including a Vulnerable Sector Screening).
