



## MENTAL HEALTH LEAD

## **RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Work with system leaders within the school board to develop a comprehensive school board strategy focused on development and implementation of a board-level system response to address student mental health and addictions needs
- Use clinical expertise and work with School Mental Health ASSIST to inform school board planning and support capacity building focused on addressing student mental health and addictions needs in schools
- Work collaboratively with Chief Psychologist and lead VTRA and Crisis Response
- Collaborate with community partners and initiatives to facilitate system navigation on behalf of the school board including participating in community committees
- Collaborate with School Mental Health ASSIST and other Mental Health Leaders to inform planning at the school board level and share learning and resources regionally and provincially
- Submit reports to the Ministry of Education as required throughout the year on project initiatives and findings
- Work collaboratively with the Chief Psychologist to plan and implement mental health and wellbeing programs and initiatives
- Duties may include supervision of Program Department Support Staff
- Other duties as assigned

## **QUALIFICATIONS:**

The Mental Health Lead will have experience that includes but is not limited to the following competencies:

- Completion of a graduate degree in Psychology and registered with a regulated College
- Experience providing and/or facilitating adult learning, professional learning and training
- Experience working with children and youth who have mental health and/or addictions issues

- Experience in clinical supervision
- Minimum of 5 years of experience working in Clinical, Counselling and/or School Psychology
