

Seeking Psychologist or Psychological Associate

Letourneau Psychological Services is a small psychology practice in Toronto's east end. Over the past four years, the practice has built a reputation for providing professional psychotherapy services to adults in Toronto and the wider GTA.

Specializing in evidence-based treatment for adults, my typical clients are seeking treatment for mood disorders, anxiety disorders, and trauma and stressor-related disorders. Special areas of interest include bipolar disorder, PTSD, adjustment disorder, and chronic insomnia. An important sub-group of clientele are young adults between the ages of 18 and 30.

Job Description and Requirements

I am seeking one or more qualified psychologists or psychological associates to join my small and growing practice. The qualified candidate(s) will have a Master's Degree or Ph.D. in clinical or counselling psychology and be registered to practice autonomously with the College of Psychologists of Ontario. Competency to practice clinical and/or counselling psychotherapy with adults is a requirement as referral sources at the practice are well established for adults. Additional areas of clinical competency are considered an asset.

The successful candidate(s) will have excellent oral and written communication skills, interpersonal skills, and the ability to work independently. Strong differential diagnosis skills are essential as is a good working knowledge of typical 'Axis I' disorders and evidence-based treatment approaches that fit within a cognitive behavioural, mindfulness-based, and/or interpersonal therapy treatment framework.

The commitment of hours is flexible. The position can provide full-time work (over a period of time necessary to build up a case load), or can supplement your existing position with part-time hours as little as one day or one evening per week.

Benefits/Compensation

The successful candidate will be considered to be an associate of the practice and an independent contractor and will invoice the practice at the end of each month. Rates are commensurate with experience and are competitive. The practice will provide some funding to associates for continuing education opportunities.

The office is located in a two-story character building and is near the intersection of Broadview Avenue and Dundas Street, close to many shops and amenities. The office is well served by the nearby Don Valley Parkway and TTC King, Dundas, and Queen streetcar routes. The building is not wheelchair accessible and has a stairwell to access offices, washrooms, and the kitchen area. The office rooms are simple, well appointed and comfortable, with large windows. A clinical library is available for borrowing books and popular psychometrics are available, with additional or preferred psychometrics acquired by the practice as needed. There will be regular opportunities for formal and informal clinical consultation.

Administrative support is available to complete most client inquiries and bookings, which will be done within the associate's preferred hours of availability.
